You may have heard that from September our school lunch provider is changing. We are happy to announce that Caterlink have taken over the contract for 47 Isle of Wight schools including Hunnyhill.

Caterlink pride themselves on:

Local Supply - they source all of our fresh ingredients including meat, fruit and vegetables and dairy products from local suppliers.

Organic – they only use organic milk in all our recipes. They also source a percentage of organic meat, fruit and vegetables in line with Food for Life, Silver and Gold Requirements.

UK Red Tractor - they only source fresh meat which is British and Red Tractor accredited. This means that meat products are fully traceable from farm to fork.

Fairtrade – All sugar, tea, coffee, cocoa, fruit juice and bananas are Fairtrade as standard on our menus.

Free Range- they make sure all of their pork and eggs are RSPCA Assured 'Free Range Freedom Food'

Caterlink have many more initiatives and additional information is on their website www.caterlinkltd.co.uk and a sample menu is available on the Hunnyhill website.

Due to this change, Chartwells, the current provider are reducing their stock amounts so for the last few days of term not all menu items will be available and there will be no jacket potatoes.

Not only will Caterlink be offering a Silver Food Standard menu the meal price from September will reduce to £1.85p per meal per day.
