We have this week once again received a call from the Manager of the HMP Central Stores at the end of Argyle Road in the estate opposite school. They have a significant growing concern that a pupil may get run over by one of the articulated lorries delivering to the stores.

Parents are now parking in their Private Parking Area just outside the stores, which the lorries use to turn around.

It should be noted that in the event of a bomb scare or other significant incident at the prison, they have the power to remove any unauthorised vehicles by whichever way deemed necessary.

I have advised them of my recent, and planned walk at the beginning and end of the school day with the local councillor - Andrew Garratt.

The prison have also been in touch with Mr Garratt as well as the police regarding this issue.

I urge you all once again to work with our neighbours and where possible, walk some or all of the way to school.

All of the children, and the adults learnt lots!

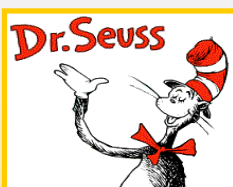


WORLD BOOK DAY 2018

Tuesday 6th February at 1:50pm

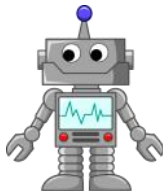
A letter has come home with children in our Year 1 classes this week inviting parents to join them in this fun Space Machine workshop.
